

Book Bags!

You should notice that your child brought home a book bag today. This book bag will be coming home every night and is to come back to school every day (whether the book was read or not). The book bag is essentially a slide top baggie that contains a book at your child's reading level. There is also a reading log that needs to be filled out every night. The reading log contains five columns: date, level, title, read to, and rate the book. For the "rate the book" column, students or adults should write whether the book was easy, a good fit, or too hard for the child. Please make sure it is your child who is reading the book every night, but the adult who is filling out the "read to" column. It is also a great idea to ask your child what he/she read about after the book is finished. A big part of finding your child's reading level is comprehension. If your child has a difficult time remembering what he/she read, then they will have a difficult time going on to the next reading level. Due to this, please refrain from emailing or sending in a note that says you feel it is time for your child to move on to the next level. This is also part of your child's homework, and I have a checklist that I mark daily if the book bag was read and signed. If your child fails to bring the book back because it is lost or damaged, please send in \$3 to help cover the cost of the book. Remember, we have some great incentives that go along with your child bringing his/her book bag back signed every day! If your child does not bring his/her Book Bag back signed on a regular basis, there will be a classroom consequence, such as no iPad that day.



Halloween

I can't believe that it is October already! I already have many students talking about what they are going to be for Halloween or what they would like to be. Even though Halloween is not until the end of the month, here are some rules that will be put in every newsletter until then for your planning purposes:

-Your child is not allowed to come to school in his/her costume
